Old Business

- Non-compliance update: 5 units reported to the city for overgrowth, 2 units cited for carport clutter, 1 unit cited for needed paint and carport clutter, 1 unit cited for late trash, 1 unit cited for trailer in western overflow parking
- Perimeter wall repair: damage has been repaired, but 5 units' side wooden fences don't connect to it by 2-3 feet
- Leaning HOA fence: one unit remains with a leaning fence; contact info given to HOA president who will pass it along to the handyman
- City Code Hearing: HOA president went to the June municipal code hearing about Sunset Point Road wall repair, but the case had been dismissed
- HOA Compliance Tips: document distributed to all units via a doorknob hanger; ones that were still there 10 days later were removed and will be redistributed around Thanksgiving
- Western overflow wall accident: police accident report was obtained and examined at the meeting; the HOA's
 insurance company inspected the damage; the at-fault car owner's insurance company was identified, and a claim
 will be filed

New Business

- Storage shed inspected and is not blocking storm sewer drain in backyard
- No abandoned vehicles have been noted
- Board voted to approve design of new HOA meeting lawn signs in time for December's meeting
- Board tabled the solar panel discussion for now
- Board voted to add a mailbox repair section to the website
- Board voted to patch the three potholes when the rainy season is over and have the outside of the perimeter wall touched-up with paint
